



How Can I Finance My Public Health Education?

“Financial Aid is like the lottery, you have to be in it to win it. Don’t automatically assume you are not eligible for any aid. The timing of your financial aid search should coincide with the submission of your application materials. Work closely with your financial aid advisor to identify resources. 15 minutes per day searching for financial sources can result in attendance at your top choice school versus your second choice option.”
