Anne Schuchat, MD, is a former rear admiral and assistant surgeon general in the United States Public Health Service Commissioned Corps, who served as the principal deputy director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) from 2015 to 2021. She served as acting CDC director from January-July 2017 and February-March 2018. Dr. Schuchat also served as director of CDC's National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases from 2006-2015 and Chief of the Respiratory Diseases Branch from 1998-2005. She joined CDC as an Epidemic Intelligence Service officer in 1988.
